Important Note: New requirements as of 2010, festival food vendors must have a sound deadening box for all generators.

Ice will be sold for \$8 per bag.

NOTE: There will be no electrical hook-ups available. Use of any University electrical outlets, generators or other hook-ups is strictly prohibited and is grounds for immediate expulsion from the Festival.

All spaces are outside on the grounds of the Lowe Art Museum in close proximity to the art exhibition area. Vendors must provide their own awnings or umbrellas if desired. Exact space boundaries will be clearly marked. Vendors are not to exceed their assigned space. Push carts must be easily moveable by Art Festival officials (if necessary).

Vendors who are cooking on the premises must have a fire extinguisher. No open fires are allowed. Use of generators by push cars vendors is prohibited. Vendors are subject to approval by the Coral Gables Fire Department and must make any changes required by the CGFD to meet all applicable laws, rules or regulations. If the Vendor does not meet the approval of the CGFD, Beaux Arts is not required to refund any monies paid by the vendor.

Vendors must set up between 2 p.m. and 4 p.m. on Friday, January 7th, 2011. Vendors should be on site and ready for business by 9 a.m. on Saturday, January 8th, and by 10 a.m. on Sunday, January 9th. Vendors must remain open until 5 p.m. each day. Any vendor leaving before 5 p.m. on either day will jeopardize his/her participation in subsequent Beaux Arts Festival of Art Events. Vendors selling items other than those listed on their application and approved by Beaux Arts officials will be asked to leave immediately.

If this application is accepted by Beaux Arts, the undersigned vender hereby agrees to occupy the space applied for, offer for sale an ample supply of the items described herein, and have all of the licenses and permits required by law. Vendor agrees: (1) that neither Beaux Arts, its members, the Lowe Art Museum or the University of Miami shall be liable for any claims, loss or damages with respect to the property of vendor, or of vendor's agents or employees, occasioned by theft, loss damage, act of God or any other reason whatsoever; (2) that neither Beaux Arts, its members, the Lowe Art Museum or the University of Miami shall be obligated to protect or safeguard the property of vendor, or of the vendor's agents or employees; and (3) to indemnify and hold Beaux Arts, its members, the Lowe Art Museum and University of Miami, or any of them, harmless from any liability for any claims, loss or damage with respect to the property of vendor or of the vendor's agents or employees occasioned by theft, loss, damage, act of God or any other reason whatsoever. Vendor further agrees to indemnify and hold Beaux Arts and its members, the Lowe Art Museum, the University of Miami and the City of Coral Gables harmless form any liability for any claims, loss or damage arising from the acts or omissions of vendor or vendor's agents or employees.

Applicant must produce a current and satisfactory certificate of insurance showing that applicant carries liability insurance covering his/her premises, operations and food products on the Lowe Art Museum/University of Miami premises. Said insurance must be minimum amounts of \$100,000 per person, \$300,000 per incident/bodily injury, \$50,000 property damage and the Beaux Arts, Lowe Art Museum, University of Miami and the City of Coral Gables shall be additional named insured's. There will be no exceptions.

This application is due no later than November 1st, 2011. One half the total rental fee and certificate of your liability insurance are due with the application. The balance is due upon notice of acceptance of the application by Beaux Arts.

Vendors must meet this deadline or they will not be permitted on the grounds. Space rental fees will not be refunded once Beaux Arts has accepted this application. No refunds will be given in the event of a breach of this contract.
